(The Song of the Liberated in Life) The Song of Dattatreya

Sarva Bhutaantarasthaaya, Nityamukta Chidaatmanae; Pratyak Chaitanya Roopaaya, Mahyamaeva Namo Namaha

 Salutations to the Transcendental Being Who is immanent in all creation, being Pure Consciousness, ever free, witness of all action Which is none other than my own Self divine.

Jeevanmuktischa Yaa Muktihi, Saa Muktihi Pindapaatanae; Yaa Muktihi Pindapatanae, Saa Muktihi Shuni Sookarae

2. Freedom from *karma* which one attains while living Is *Jeevan Mukti*, the great liberation of the Being; Liberation after the death of the body is not possible Unless one attains it while living in this body mortal.

Jeevaha Shivaha Sarvamaeva, Bhutaeshvaevam Vyavasthitaha Aevamaevacha Pashyam Hi, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

3. The Self is in reality Shiva itself It is one without a second—Universal Self; One who sees this truth in all and in oneself Is a liberated *Jeevan Mukta* himself.

Aevam Brahma Jagatsarvam, Akhilam Bhaasatae Ravihi; Samsthitam Sarva Bhutaanaam, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae 4. Even as the whole world is illumined by the sun The whole creation is illumined by Brahman; One who realizes this immanent Reality Is liberated while living from all duality.

Aekadhaa Bahudhaa Chaiva, Drishyatae Jalachandravat; Aatmajnaani Tathaivaeko, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

5. Reflected in different lakes, rivers and ocean The one moon appears as many, but it is only one; One Self appears in many forms, but it is only one Liberated is he, one who sees many in one.

Sarvabhutae Sthitam Brahma, Bhedabhedo Na Vidyatae; Aekamaevaabhi Pashyamscha, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

6. All-pervasive is this immanent Truth
Difference, non-difference exists not in Truth—it is myth;
One who realizes this Truth of Brahman
Is a *Jeevan Mukta*, liberated Atman.

Tattvam Kshetram Vyomaateetam, Aham Kshetrajna Uchyatae; Aham Kartaacha Bhoktaacha, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

7. Universe is body and Brahman, its soul, Transcends the space, our immortal goal; I am the actor, enjoyer as well—
One who sees this is a liberated soul.

Karmaendriya Parityaagi, Dhyaana Varjita Chaetasaha; Atmajnani Tathaivaeko, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

8. Transcending senses of action and mind Uniting with Self, that illumined mind Forthwith attains the *Jeevan Mukti*By way of knowledge known as *jnana shakti*.

Shaareeram Kevalam Karma, Shoka Mohaadi Varjitam;

Shubhaashubha Parityagi, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

9. Even while acting, one who is free from affliction Misery or gain, one who has no concern; Who is free from attachment and infatuation Is known as *Jeevan Mukta*, the liberated one.

Karma Sarvatraadishtam, Na Jaanaami Cha Kinchana; Karma Brahma Vijaanaati, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

10. I know not an action separated from Brahman Brahman is *karma*, and *karma* Brahman; One who thus sees all action as God, Liberated is he while on earthly abode.

Chinmayam Vyaapitam Sarvam, Aakaasham Jagadeeshvaram; Sahitam Sarva Bhutaanaam, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

11. God is the Universal Spirit that pervades all space And He is the Self of all beings who live in time and space; One who sees this God-Self in all, everywhere Liberated in life, he is happy here and hereafter.

Anaadivarti Bhutaanaam, Jeevaha Shivo Na Hanyatae; Nirvairaha Sarva Bhutaeshu, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

12. Soul of all creatures is Shiva Himself He has no death, He is eternal Self; One who hates not, seeing all this as Self *Jeevan Mukta* is he, the blissful great Self.

Atmaa Guruhu Tvam Vishvam Cha, Chidaakaasho Na Lipyatae; Gataagatam Dvayoho Naasti, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

13. Self is the Guru, Self is all this Self is unaffected, Self is supreme bliss; It grows not, diminishes not, it is always the same Liberated is he, one who realizes this OM. Garbhadhyanaena Pashyanti, Jnaaninam Mana Uchyatae; Soham Mano Vileeyantae, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

14. Meditation leads to the Cosmic Mind, that "I AM" Such an illumined mind is not separate from that "I AM" All-pervading Shiva is that great Self "I AM" He is liberated in life, one who identifies with that "I AM."

Oordhva Dhyaanaena Pashyanti, Vijnaanam Mana Uchyatae; Shoonyam Layam Cha Vilayam, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

15. The wise see the Truth through the highest meditation Some call it void, and some call it absorption; Some call it Cosmic Mind, some illumination One who sees this Truth has attained liberation.

Abhyaasae Ramatae Nityam, Mano Dhyaana Layam Gatam; Bandha Moksha Dvayam Naasti, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

16. He who delights in deep meditation
Dwelling in the Truth for Self-realization,
He is free from the relative thoughts of bondage and freedom
He is *Jeevan Mukta*, liberated from thralldom.

Aekaaki Ramatae Nityam, Svabhaava Guna Varjitam; Brahma-Jnaana Rasaasvadee, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

17. He is *Jeevan Mukta* who is absorbed in the joy of Atman Transcending three *gunas*, he delights in Brahman; Dwelling in the great Self, he enjoys the essence of Truth Liberated is he by transcending birth and death.

Hridi Dhyaanaena Pashyanti, Prakaasham Kriyatae Manha; Soham Hamsaeti Pashyanti, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

18. He sees the great Self in the heart's lotus through meditation He feels oneness with God through such illumination; His mind and breath constantly repeat I am He, He I am—Hamsa Soham Soham Hamsa
Liberated in life is such a Master, a paramahamsa.

Shiva Shakti Samaatmaanam, Pinda-Brahmaanda Maevacha; Chidaakaasham Hridam Moham, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

19. Seeing Shiva and Shakti in his great Self as one and the same Seeing macrocosm in microcosm as one and the same; Seeing the whole universe and the Universal Truth in his great Self Forthwith he attains liberation in life by realizing the Supreme Self.

Jaagrit Svapna Sushuptim Cha, Turyaavasthitam Sadaa; Soham Mano Vileeyaeta, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

20. Transcending wakeful, dream and deep sleep state, Dwelling constantly in "Soham," I Am He, the transcendental state, Merging the mind in that infinite consciousness

Attains he the *Jeevan Mukti* state of absolute consciousness.

Soham Sthitam Jnaanamidam, Sootraeshu Manivatparam; Soham Brahma Niraakaaram, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

21. God is like the string, souls are like the beads; The affirmation of "He I Am" is the *mantra*, that which leads Towards the Truth, formless, nameless and of the nature of peace Realizing which *Jeevan Mukta* enjoys the divine bliss.

Mana Aeva Manushyaanaam, Bhedaabhedasya Kaaranam; Vikalpa Naiva Samkalpam, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

22. It is the mind that is the cause of seeing difference and non-difference "I know," "I know not" is the nature of the mind that has not tasted the divine essence; One who stills the mind with the aid of reflection and meditation He is *Jeevan Mukta*, the unfettered Atman.

Mana Aeva Viduhu Praajnaha, Siddha-Siddhanta Aeva Cha; Sadaa Dridam Tadaa Moksha, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

23. When the mind and the heart become steadfast in Brahman Settled in Truth is such a person;

He is a *siddha* who is established in Truth He is *Jeevan Mukta* and has conquered the death.

Yogaabhyaasee Manaha Shrestaha, Antastyagee Bahirjadaha; Antastyaagee Bahistyagee, Jeevanmuktaha Sa Uchyatae

24. Whoever practices this *yoga* of Universal Truth, Renounces inwardly all worldly riches as myth; One who renounces all desires both from without and within Such a one is a *Jeevan Mukta*, a liberated Atman.

Iti Vedanta-Kesarinaa Sri Dattatreyaena Virachitaa Jeevanmukti-Gita Samaapta OM Shantihi Shantihi

Thus ends this great song of liberation while living Composed by Lord Dattatreya, the Master of Masters, everliving; He is Trinity—Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva—incarnated as Master Lion of Vedanta, God, our Lord and Teacher.
